An Act to perpetuate "The Early Closing Act, 1900,"
and for other purposes.

[*Assented to, October 30th, 1903.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of
the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Early Closing Perpetuation Act, 1903," and shall be incorporated and read with the "Early Closing Act, 1900," hereinafter called the principal Act, and the Acts amending the same. Short title.

2. Section 26 of the principal Act is hereby repealed, so that the said Act shall be permanent. Principal Act made permanent.

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—"The Metropolitan Shopping District shall consist of the electoral Assembly districts of Adelaide, Port Adelaide, and Torrens, as constituted under 'The Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1901.'" Metropolitan Shopping District.
