An Act to amend "The Licensed Victuallers Act, 1880."

[Assented to, August 27th, 1902.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Licensed Victuallers Act Further Amendment Act, 1902," and shall be read and construed with "The Licensed Victuallers Act, 1880," and with all other Acts incorporated therewith. Short title.

2. In this Act "Distiller" means any person holding a distillation licence under any statutory enactment in force in the Commonwealth of Australia. Definition.

3. From and after the passing of this Act a storekeeper's licence, heretofore or hereafter issued to any person being a distiller, shall, notwithstanding the provisions of any Act to the contrary, be deemed to authorise and empower any such distiller to sell and dispose of liquor in the house or on the premises therein specified, in quantities of not less at one time than two gallons of one kind of spirits, or one dozen reputed quart bottles, or two dozen reputed pint bottles of wine or other fermented liquor to be taken away at one time by one person, and not to be drunk on the premises in which such liquor is sold. A distiller holding a storekeeper's licence authorised to sell two gallons of one kind of spirits, &c.

4. Any storekeeper's licence granted hereafter to a distiller shall have written at the head thereof "For distillers," and shall, prior to the same being issued, be amended so as to have embodied therein all the words contained in section 3 necessary for giving effect to the provisions of the said section. Licence to distiller to be headed "For distillers."

The Licensed Victuallers Act Further Amendment Act.—1902.

Holder of distiller's licence not to hold storekeeper's or wine licence.

5. No distiller, while holding a storekeeper's licence for distillers, shall hold a storekeeper's licence or wine licence. Any grant of either of such last-mentioned licences to a distiller holding a storekeeper's licence for distillers shall be void and of none effect.

Provisions relating to storekeeper's licence to apply to a storekeeper's licence for distillers.

6. All the provisions of the Acts read and incorporated herewith applicable to a storekeeper's licence shall, except where inconsistent herewith or inapplicable hereto, apply to a storekeeper's licence for distillers.

Distillation licence, evidence of qualification.

7. The production of a distillation licence issued to any applicant shall be evidence of his qualification to apply for a storekeeper's licence for distillers.
