An Act to amend the Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act, 1937.

[Assented to 12th October, 1944.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act Amendment Act, 1944".

(2) The Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act, 1937, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act, 1937-1944".

(3) The Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act, 1937, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

**Amendment of s. 5 of the principal Act—
Members of Council.**

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (1) thereof the following passage:—

(e) a veterinary officer of the Public Service of the State nominated by the Minister of Agriculture.
