An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1934-1947.

[Assented to 11th December, 1947.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Road Traffic Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1947 ". Short titles.

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Road Traffic Act, 1934-1947 ".

(3) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1947, is hereinafter called " the principal Act ".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 10a thereof :— Enactment of section 10b of principal Act—

10b. (1) If the Registrar is satisfied by such evidence as he requires that— Concessions to incapacitated ex-servicemen.

(a) a motor vehicle is owned by a person who has been a member of a naval, military, or air force of His Majesty ; and

(b) the owner, as a result of his service in a naval, military, or air force, is totally and permanently incapacitated, or is blind, or has lost a leg or foot, or by reason of impairment of his power of locomotion receives a pension under the

Australian Soldiers Repatriation Act, 1920-1943, of not less than seventy-five per centum of the pension payable for total incapacity ; and

(c) that motor vehicle will during the period for which it is sought to be registered be wholly or mainly used for the transport of the owner,

the registration fee for that motor vehicle shall be half of the amount payable under paragraphs (1) to (6) inclusive, of section 9, and sections 9a, 9b, and 10 of this Act.

(2) The registration of a vehicle registered at a reduced fee under this section shall not be transferable.

(3) When a person ceases to be the owner of a vehicle registered at a reduced fee under this section he shall be entitled upon compliance with section 21 of this Act, to a payment or credit as provided in that section ; and the registration of the vehicle, if not sooner cancelled, shall become void upon the expiration of twenty-one days after that person ceased to be the owner of it.
