An Act to amend the Fruit Fly Act, 1947-1948.

[Assented to 10th November, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fruit Fly Act Amendment Act, 1949". Short titles.

(2) The Fruit Fly Act, 1947-1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Fruit Fly Act, 1947-1949".

(3) The Fruit Fly Act, 1947-1948, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "forty-eight" in subsection (2) thereof the words "or the year nineteen hundred and forty-nine". Amendment of s. 4 of principal Act—
Right to compensation.

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) thereof and inserting in its place the following subsections :— Amendment of s. 5 of principal Act—
Claims for compensation.

(1) A person claiming compensation under this Act shall give to the committee a notice of claim in the form fixed and provided by the committee for the purpose and shall supply the committee with all the information indicated in the form.

(1a) Every such notice—

(a) shall be signed by the claimant ;

(b) if the claim is for loss resulting from the prohibition of growing or planting any plant or from the prohibition of removing fruit or vegetables from any land, shall be delivered to the committee before the thirty-first day of December in the year in which that proclamation imposing prohibition was made, or before the expiration of three months after the making of that proclamation, whichever is later ;

(c) if the claim is for loss resulting from any act, shall be delivered to the committee not later than three months after the end of October next following the day on which that act was done.

The signature of a claimant to a notice of claim shall be witnessed by a justice of the peace or a member of the police force.
