An Act to amend the Enfield General Cemetery Act,
1944-1949.

[Assented to 1st November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Enfield General
Cemetery Act Amendment Act, 1956".

(2) The Enfield General Cemetery Act, 1944-1949, as amended
by the Enfield General Cemetery (Exchange of Land) Act, 1952,
and by this Act, may be cited as the "Enfield General Cemetery
Act, 1944-1956".

(3) The Enfield General Cemetery Act, 1944-1949, is herein-
after referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of
principal Act,
s. 23—
Interest on
advances.

2. Section 23 of the principal Act is amended by striking
out the words "the rate of four pounds per centum per annum
which" in subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof
the words "such rate or rates as the Treasurer from time to
time determines, and the Treasurer may determine different
rates to be payable in respect of moneys advanced at different
times. All such interest".
