An Act to amend the Police Offences Act,  
1953-1960.

[Assented to 24th November, 1960.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Offences Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1960". Short titles

(2) The Police Offences Act, 1953-1960, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Offences Act, 1953-1960".

(3) The Police Offences Act, 1953-1960, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 58 thereof :— Enactment of s. 58a of principal Act—

58a. (1) The driver or conductor of an omnibus or any member of the police force may request a person who has entered the omnibus to depart therefrom if— Objectionable persons in omnibuses and their removal therefrom.

(a) before or at the time when the person entered the omnibus, he was informed by the driver or conductor that it was fully loaded with passengers ;

(6) If any such person produces false evidence with respect to his name or address he shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Twenty pounds or imprisonment for three months.
