An Act to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to
Animals Act, 1936-1960.

[Assented to 5th November, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act Amendment Act, 1964". Short titles.

(2) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1960, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1964".

(3) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1960, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the word "constable" (wherever occurring) in subsection (2) thereof the words "or veterinary surgeon" in each case; and

(b) by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection :—

Killing of
animals.

(3) In subsection (2) of this section, "veterinary surgeon" means a person who is registered as a veterinary surgeon pursuant to section 17 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1935-1957.
