### No. 13 of 1965

An Act to amend the Associations Incorporation Act, 1956-1963.

[Assented to 21st October, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “Associations Incorporation Act Amendment Act, 1965”. Short titles.

(2) The Associations Incorporation Act, 1956-1963, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the “Associations Incorporation Act, 1956-1965”.

(3) The Associations Incorporation Act, 1956-1963, is hereinafter referred to as “the principal Act”.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Subsection (2) of section 10 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word “An” being the first word of that subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “Except with the consent of the Attorney-General, an”. Amendment of principal Act, s. 10 (2).
