An Act to amend the Evidence Act, 1929-1960.

[Assented to 19th December, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Evidence Act Amendment Act, 1968".

(2) The Evidence Act, 1929-1960, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Evidence Act, 1929-1968".

(3) The Evidence Act, 1929-1960, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 14— Aboriginal wilfully making false statement not on oath.

2. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage " , and further to be once, twice, or thrice publicly or privately whipped".
