An Act to amend the Law of Property Act, 1936-1966.

[Assented to 4th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Law of Property Act Amendment Act, 1969". Short titles.

(2) The Law of Property Act, 1936-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Law of Property Act, 1936-1969".

(3) The Law of Property Act, 1936-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "thereof" in the definition of "court" the passage "and for the purposes of Part VIII of this Act, means the division of that court entitled the Land and Valuation Court, constituted under the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969". Amendment of principal Act, s. 7— Interpretation.
