**An Act to amend the Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act, 1925-1968**

[Assented to 11th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act Amendment Act, 1969". Short titles.

(2) The Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act, 1925-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act, 1925-1969".

(3) The Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act, 1925-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "judge" wherever it occurs therein the passage "or Recorder". Amendment of principal Act, s. 3—  
Legal aid for persons accused of indictable offences.
