An Act to amend the Bulk Handling of Grain Act,  
1955-1968.

[Assented to 11th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Bulk Handling of Grain Act Amendment Act, 1969".

(2) The Bulk Handling of Grain Act, 1955-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Bulk Handling of Grain Act, 1955-1969".

(3) The Bulk Handling of Grain Act, 1955-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Enactment of  
s. 19b of  
principal Act—

2. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act immediately after section 19a thereof :—

Company may  
refuse to  
accept delivery  
of wheat.

19b. Notwithstanding anything in this Act or in any other enactment, the company may, in relation to—

(a) the season which commenced on the first day of October, 1969 ;

or

(b) any season which is a quota season as defined in  
the Wheat Delivery Quotas Act, 1969,  
refuse to accept delivery of any wheat.
