An Act to amend the Phylloxera Act, 1936-1966.

[Assented to 27th February, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Phylloxera Act Amendment Act, 1969".

(2) The Phylloxera Act, 1936-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Phylloxera Act, 1936-1969".

(3) The Phylloxera Act, 1936-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Interpretation.

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "disease" and inserting in lieu thereof the following definition :—

"disease" means the disease in grape vines known as phylloxera which is caused by *Viteus Vitifoliae* (Fitch.).

3. Section 38a of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (b) the following paragraph :—

- (c) undertake such research as in its opinion is necessary to develop and test virus free clonal selections of varieties of root stocks and scions and evaluate the material used for such research and make such of it as is appropriate available to the viticultural industry.
