An Act to amend the Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Underground Waters Preservation Act Amendment Act, 1970". Short titles.
- (2) The Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969-1970".
- (3) The Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 51 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Repeal of s. 51 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place.

51. (1) The institution of an appeal shall not suspend, or otherwise affect, the operation of any decision or direction subject to appeal.

Institution of appeal not to affect decision or direction.

(2) This section shall apply in respect of any decision or direction whether made or given before or after the commencement of the Underground Waters Preservation Act Amendment Act, 1970.
