## No. 8 of 1971

An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1970.

[Assented to 1st April, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Act Amend- Short titles.  
ment Act, 1971".
- (2) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1970, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Agent-General Act, 1901-1971".
- (3) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1970, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of April, Commence-  
ment.

paragraphs (a) and (b) from subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraphs:—

- (a) as from and including the first day of April, 1971, a salary at the rate of five thousand pounds sterling a year;
- and
- (b) as from and including the first day of April, 1971, an expenses allowance at the rate of four thousand two hundred pounds sterling a year.
