An Act to amend the Bills of Sale Act, 1886-1970.

[Assented to 30th November, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Bills of Sale Act Amendment Act, 1972".

(2) The Bills of Sale Act, 1886-1970, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Bills of Sale Act, 1886-1972".

(3) The Bills of Sale Act, 1886-1970, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 28—
Bills of sale to be void in certain cases.

3. Section 28 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the present contents thereof (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) A bill of sale that constitutes a consumer mortgage within the meaning of the Consumer Transactions Act, 1972, shall not be rendered void as against any person under subsection (1) of this section by reason of the fact that it is not registered.
