An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1972.

[Assented to 20th September, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Act Amend- Short titles.
ment Act, 1973".

(2) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Agent-General Act, 1901-1973".

(3) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1972, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Commence-
ment.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (a) from subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—

(a) as from, and including, the fourth day of June, 1973, and until, but not including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, a salary at the rate of eleven thousand two hundred and

ninety-seven dollars a year and as from, and including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, a salary at the rate of fourteen thousand seven hundred dollars a year;;

and

(b) by striking out paragraph (b) from subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—

(b) as from and including the day of commencement of the Agent-General Act Amendment Act, 1973, an expenses allowance at the rate of ten thousand one hundred dollars a year,.
