**No. 90 of 1981****An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1981.***[Assented to 23 December 1981]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act (No. 4), 1981".

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1961-1981".

2. Section 85 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (a) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph:

(a) declare—

(i) any part of a street that abuts on the site of either House of Parliament or of the Constitutional Museum of South Australia;

or

(ii) any part of the site of the Constitutional Museum of South Australia,

to be a prohibited area;;

and

(b) by striking out subsection (4).
