An Act to amend the Parole Orders (Transfer) Act, 1983.

[Assented to 17 December 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Parole Orders (Transfer) Act Amendment Act, 1987". Short title.

(2) The Parole Orders (Transfer) Act, 1983, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (3) " , or any statement or certificate of conviction or warrant of commitment, or a certified copy of such a document, evidencing the parolee's liability to undergo that imprisonment". Amendment of s. 6—
Request for registration of parole order under corresponding law.

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph: Amendment of s. 9—
Registration.

(b) keep the endorsed parole order in a register together with the original or copy of the judgment, order, statement or certificate of conviction or warrant of commitment sent by the designated authority, being the judgment or order by virtue of which the parolee became liable to undergo the imprisonment to which the parole order relates, or the statement or certificate of conviction or warrant of commitment evidencing the parolee's liability to undergo that imprisonment;;

and

(b) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (2) "judgment or order" and substituting "judgment, order, statement or certificate of conviction or warrant of commitment".
