An Act to amend the Dentists Act, 1984.

[Assented to 26 October 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Dentists Act Amendment Act, 1989*.
- (2) The *Dentists Act, 1984*, is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

Restriction of provision of dental treatment by unqualified persons

2. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) “No person may recover a fee or other charge for dental treatment provided by him” and substituting “A person must not provide dental treatment for fee or reward”;

and

(b) by inserting at the end of subsection (1) “Penalty: Five thousand dollars or imprisonment for six months.”.
