An Act to vest a certain portion of the Adelaide Park Lands in the South Australian Railways Commissioner, and to enable another portion thereof to be taken possession of by the Commissioner of Public Works.

[Assented to, December 18th, 1913.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as “The Adelaide Park Lands Alteration Act, 1913.” Short title.

2. All that piece of land, being portion of the Adelaide Park Lands, delineated in the plan in the Schedule to this Act and therein hatched in black and marked “A” is hereby vested in the South Australian Railways Commissioner for an estate of inheritance in fee simple for the purposes of “The South Australian Railways Commissioners Act, 1887,” and the Acts amending that Act, or of any Act substituted for that Act. Part of Adelaide Park Lands vested in Railways Commissioner.

3. The Commissioner of Public Works may take possession of and retain all that piece of land, being other portion of the Adelaide Park Lands, delineated in the plan in the Schedule to this Act and therein hatched in black and marked “B”; and the said Commissioner may thereon erect such buildings, and make such other improvements, Other part of the said Park Lands may be taken for Police Barracks.

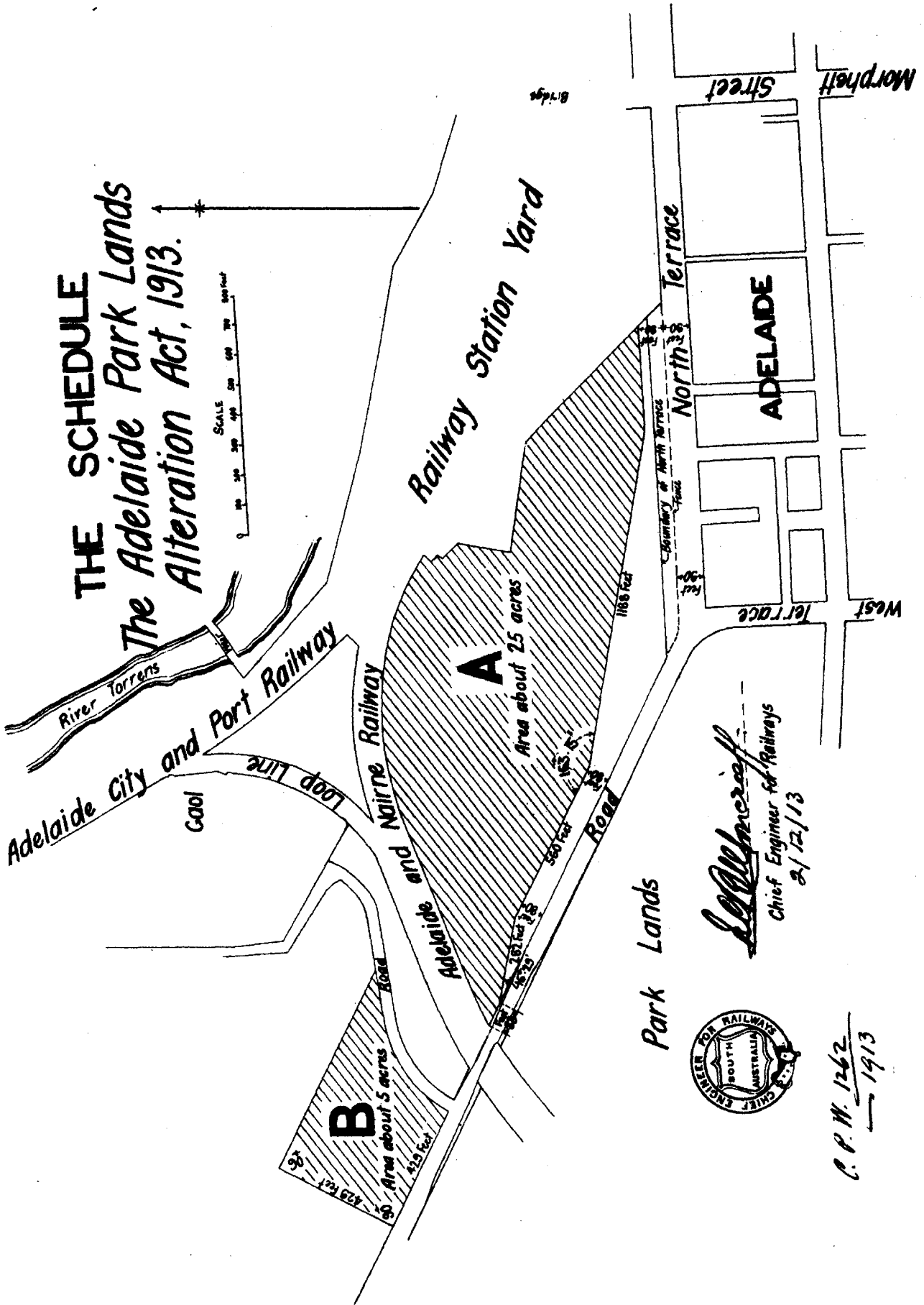
