An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Act
Further Amendment Act, 1919.

[Assented to, December 21st, 1922.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Workmen's Com- Short titles.
pensation Act Further Amendment Act, 1922."

(2) The Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1920, and this
Act may be cited together as the "Workmen's Compensation Acts,
1911 to 1922."

2. Section 3 of the Workmen's Compensation Act Further Amendment of Act
Amendment Act, 1919, is amended by striking out the fourteenth, 1379, 1919, s. 3—
fifteenth, and sixteenth lines thereof, and substituting therefor the Amount of compensa-
following passage:— tion in case of
incapacity for work.

11. Thirty Shillings if he is at the time of the accident a single man or a widower not having any child wholly or partially dependent upon his earnings, and Two Pounds if he is at the time of the accident a married man or a widower having one or more children wholly or partially dependent upon his earnings.
