An Act to amend the Advances for Homes Acts, 1910 to 1922.

[Assented to, November 14th, 1923.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Advances for Homes Act Further Amendment Act, 1923." Short title.

(2) The Advances for Homes Acts, 1910 to 1922, and this Act may be cited together as the "Advances for Homes Acts, 1910 to 1923."

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with other Acts.

3. Section 11 of the Advances for Homes Act, 1910, is amended by substituting for the words "four-fifths" in subsections (3), (4), and (5) the words "six-sevenths". Amendment of sec. 11 of the principal Act—Advances for Homes.

4. Section 6 of the Advances for Homes Act Further Amendment Act, 1920, is amended by substituting for the word "four" in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof the word "two". Amendment of Act 1440 of 1920, sec. 6—Parent of two children to be qualified for same assistance as returned soldier.
