An Act to amend the Irrigation Acts, 1922 to 1925,
and for other purposes.

[Assented to, January 5th, 1928.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Irrigation Act Amendment Act, 1927". Short titles.

(2) The Irrigation Acts, 1922 to 1925, and this Act may be cited together as the "Irrigation Acts, 1922 to 1927".

(3) The Irrigation Act, 1922, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1546 of 1922.

2. Section 57A of the principal Act (as enacted by section 4 of the Irrigation Act Amendment Act, 1924), is amended— Amendment of principal Act, s. 57A—

(a) by inserting before the word "Land" in the first line thereof the passage "Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 46 and 47, any"; Power to lease land in irrigation areas.

(b) by striking out the words "other than blocks and township allotments" in the first and second lines thereof; and

(c) by inserting after the word "conditions" in the third line thereof the words "and in such area or areas".

3. Section 16 of the Irrigation Act Amendment Act, 1924, is amended by striking out the passage "before the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-five" in subsection (1) thereof. Amendment of 1650, 1924, s. 16—
Re-valuation of township allotments.
