An Act for the further Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year ending June thirtieth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and to apply out of the General Revenue, the sum of Three Hundred and Seventy-seven Thousand Pounds to the service of the Nine Months ending the thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-five.

[Assented, to 9th December, 1864.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Out of the General Revenue of the said Province, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall be issued and applied, in the manner hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified, that is to say—For defraying the Excess of Expenditure for the Government Establishments and Public Services beyond the Grants for the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, the sum of Twenty-three Thousand Four Hundred and Thirteen Pounds Ten Shillings and Eleven Pence, the said amount being appropriated as follows, viz.—

2. Out of the General Revenue of the said Province there shall be issued and applied, from time to time, for the service of the nine months ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, in addition to the sum of One Hundred and Ten Thousand Pounds applied by the Act No. 1 of 1864, intituled "An Act to apply out of the General Revenue, the sum of One Hundred and Ten Thousand Pounds, to the service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-five," any sums of money, not exceeding in the whole Three Hundred and Seventy-seven Thousand Pounds, to such services as shall have been voted by the House of Assembly aforesaid.
