An Act to amend the Cornsacks Acts, 1931 to 1934.

[Assented to, 31st October, 1935.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cornsacks Act Amendment Act, 1935". Short titles.

(2) The Cornsacks Acts, 1931 to 1934, and this Act may be cited together as the "Cornsacks Acts, 1931 to 1935".

(3) The Cornsacks Act, 1931, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 2016 of 1931.

2. Section 9 of the principal Act (as amended by section 2 of the Cornsacks Act Amendment Act, 1932, section 2 of the Cornsacks Act Amendment Act, 1933, and section 2 of the Cornsacks Act Amendment Act, 1934) is further amended by striking out the word "thirty-five" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-six".
