An Act to amend the Main Roads Amendment Act, 1865.

[Assented to, 16th March, 1866.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act No. 16 of 1865, Preamble.
intituled "An Act to amend Act No. 13 of 1860," intituled
"An Act to declare Main Lines of Road in South Australia"—Be
it therefore Enacted, by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of
South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present
Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. In addition to the lines of road set forth in the Schedule to Declaration of certain
roads as Main Roads.
Act No. 16 of 1865, the lines of road described in the Schedule
to this Act shall and the same are hereby declared to be Main
Roads of the Province of South Australia, for the purposes of all
Acts now or hereafter to be in force relating to or affecting the
Main Roads of the said Province.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to
this Act.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

Continuation of Stony Creek Branch.—From Howard's Corner, South Rhine, by Eden Valley to Flaxman's Valley.

On the South Road.—From Bryant's Corner to the Yankalilla Jetty.

Port Noarlunga Branch.—From Main South Road, near Noarlunga, to Port Noarlunga.

From Chandler's Hill to Port Noarlunga.

From the Forest Inn, on the South Road, to the Port Road, at or near Thebarton.
