PREMIER'S TRIP TO NORTHERN TOWNS.

The Premier, Mr. Dunstan, will visit towns in the North of the State over the coming weekend (Friday June 25 to Tuesday June 29).

Accompanied by Mr. Frank Blevins M.L.C., the Premier will visit Woomera, Andamooka, Coober Pedy, Leigh Creek and Port Pirie.

Mr. Dunstan will arrive at Woomera on Friday afternoon after presenting a Good Design Certificate to the agricultural machinery firm of Shearers at Mannum. After an inspection of the Woomera base, Mr. Dunstan will speak at a public meeting on Friday evening, attend a dinner given for him by the local A.L.P. sub branch and, on Saturday morning, inspect the town's youth centre.

On Saturday afternoon the Premier will fly to Coober Pedy where he will tour the towns mines and talk to local community leaders. A dinner for 100 people has been arranged in Coober Pedy for Saturday evening.

On Sunday Mr. Dunstan will fly to Andamooka in the morning and will have talks with the Andamooka Progress Association on matters concerning the development of the town. In the afternoon he will fly to Leigh Creek for a barbecue organised by A.L.P. supporters at Beltana.

On Monday he will inspect the Leigh Creek School and at 10.30 address E.T.S.A. employees. If time permits, Mr. Dunstan will meet a deputation from the Far North Development Association. He will leave for Port Pirie that afternoon and the next morning will open the natural gas spur pipeline to Port Pirie.
