from the Premier

The Premier, Mr. Dunstan, is to visit Mount Gambier and Port MacDonnell over the coming weekend.

Accompanied by Dr. John Cornwall M.L.C., the Premier will arrive in Mount Gambier at 9.00 am on Friday morning and will leave Sunday morning.

On Friday morning the Premier will do a talkback radio show on 5SE, hold a press conference, inspect extensions to the Fletcher Jones factory and also inspect the Woods and Forests Department site.

The Premier said yesterday he was especially interested to have a look at the caves around the woods and forests area because of proposed redevelopment of the area.

Shortly before lunchtime the Premier will address employees of the Mount Gambier City Council and after lunch will visit Boendick Lodge. Later in the afternoon he will visit Port MacDonnell to inspect the breakwater and will return for a civic reception at the Mount Gambier town hall at 6 pm. He will later address a meeting of the Mount Gambier sub branch of the Labor Party at the College of Further Education.

On Saturday morning the Premier will go to Glencoe to inspect the old wool shed which has been donated to the National Trust and for which the National Trust of Mount Gambier have asked the State Government for financial assistance. At 11.30 am the Premier will walk up Commercial Street to the Park Hotel and in the afternoon he will present the Hunt Club Trophy at the Glenburnie Races, attend the North vs South match at Vansittart Park and visit the West's football club.

That evening the Premier will be the official guest of the Mount Gambier Italian Club at their cabaret at Casadio Park. The Premier will leave for Adelaide Sunday morning.
