MESSAGE FROM THE SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PREMIER, DON DUNSTAN,
TO AUSTRALIA - U.S.S.R. SOCIETY. 6.3.74

I am delighted to have been given this opportunity to send a message of goodwill to the Australia-U.S.S.R. Society at its fifth National Conference.

It is a matter of pride to us that the Society has as its patron that distinguished South Australian, Sir Mark Oliphant. It is also a reflection of the importance that South Australians generally attach to the maintenance of friendly relations with the Soviet Union.
