MESSAGE FROM THE PREMIER, MR. DUNSTAN.

The situation in Cyprus has assumed tragic dimensions.

The overthrow of President Makarios and the armed intervention of Turkey has brought renewed bloodshed and bitterness.

Now there is the terrible plight of the 250,000 refugees, driven from their homes.

Action at an international level is urgently needed to restore and maintain peace in that unhappy island.

I express my sympathy to members of the South Australian Cypriot community on the occasion of this public protest.
