RECORDED RADIO ANNOUNCEMENT BY DON DUNSTAN

D.A.D. Hello. This is Don Dunstan.

The Wine Excise Tax - imposed in 1970 by the Gorton Government and continued by the McMahon Government - has crippled the growth of South Australia's wine industry.

Before 1970 the wine industry was one of the few rural industries with a sound growth rate.

The Gorton and McMahon governments repeatedly refused the Stat Government's requests for its repeal.

Only a Federal Labor Government can and will abolish the tax - and this will be done early in the life of the new Federal Parliament if Labor is elected.

The tax will not be replaced by any other form of tax.

This is an absolute committment by Gough Whitlam.

Vote for the party that looks after the real interests of the country man. Vote Labor on December 2nd.
