PRESS RELEASE BY THE PREMIER, HON. DON DUNSTAN, M.C., M.P.,

20-11-67.

The Premier, Mr. Dunstan, today announced that up to 120 new Housing Trust homes in the Smithfield area will be taken over gradually by the Army.

Mr. Dunstan said that with the 9th R.A.R. being raised at Woodside next year, and with the move of the Army School of Military Intelligence from Sydney also to Woodside, the Army's housing requirements had increased substantially. It has always been the Government's policy to provide housing for new industries and the expansion of industry, and the same policy applies to the Army.
