PRESS RELEASE BY THE PREMIER, HON. DON DUNSTAN, O.C., M.P.

18.12.67.

The fact that the number of persons registered for employment in South Australia was down to the Australian average was pleasing, the Premier, Mr. Dunstan, said today. He was commenting on the monthly employment figures released by the Minister of Labour and Industry in Canberra.

For some time, the South Australian figure had been in excess of the Australian average, Mr. Dunstan said, and the present situation reflected the increase in industrial development within the State. It was particularly pleasing because at this time of the year there is to be expected an increase in the numbers becoming available for employment because of the registration of people leaving school and other people about to commence employment.
