MESSAGE FROM THE PREMIER, HON. DON DUNSTAN, Q.C., M.P.

In the last three years, South Australia has seen a rate of reform in legislation and administration never previously achieved here. Indeed not only in the other States of Australia but overseas, South Australia has become now renowned for the rate of its social change and progress.

The Government has presented a policy for the next three years clearly outlining what we propose to do, how we propose to do it, and how it is to be financed. No comparable programme has been presented by our opponents either as specific in detail or in the methods of financing and carrying out what is proposed. The Government's programme, moreover, will ensure that every citizen of this State has an effective voice in his own future and that simple majorities of the citizens can elect or reject Governments.

In the next three years, under Labor, South Australia will have as exciting a period of development and reform as in the last three, and under a Labor Government South Australia will return to that proud position which it held in the last century as the leader of the world in innovations for the benefits of its people.
