PRESS STATEMENT FOR LEADER OF OPPOSITION, HON. DON DUNSTAN,
Q.C., M.P. AUGUST 16, 1968

The Leader of the Opposition, Mr. Dunstan will open the biennial conference of the Law Society of Western Australia at Geraldton this weekend.

He will leave for Perth this morning.

Mr. Dunstan will speak to students at the University of West Australia this afternoon on "Recent Political Events in South Australia".

About 400 delegates are expected to be at the Law Society Conference which the Leader will open on Saturday night.

In his opening lecture on Saturday Mr. Dunstan will talk on "Representative, Democratic Government and the Law."

Mr. Dunstan will confer with members of the Western Australian Parliamentary Labor Party on Monday morning before returning to Adelaide on Monday afternoon.
