PRESS STATEMENT: 28th October, 1970.

FROM: PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

SUBJECT: TANUNDA TOILETS

The Premier and Minister of Development and Mines (Mr. Dunstan) said today Cabinet had approved a \$1,500 subsidy towards the estimated cost of \$10,000 for the building of additional public toilets at the Tanunda Recreation Park.

He said it was not general practice for the Government to grant subsidies for toilet blocks at country ovals but Tanunda was a special case.

"The Chairman of the District Council of Tanunda (Mr. Harold Gilding) has informed me that up to 10 buses a day are calling at the oval to use its facilities.

"In addition, people attending the Barossa Valley Vintage Festival and other special events are creating an urgent need for more facilities."

Mr. Dunstan said an additional \$25,000 was being spent on improvements to the Show Hall.

"Previous Government subsidies amounting to \$1,000 have been paid towards the cost of \$4,600 for toilet facilities at the Tanunda Recreation Park.
