PRESS STATEMENT: 4th November, 1970.

FROM: PREMIER & MINISTER OF DEVELOPMENT (MR. DUNSTAN)

SUBJECT: LUCKY BAY - TOILET BLOCK

The Premier and Minister of Development (Mr. Dunstan) said today Cabinet had approved of a \$750 subsidy towards the estimated cost of \$2,560 for the building of a toilet block at Lucky Bay.

Mr. Dunstan said ~~Franklin~~^{Lucky} Bay was an attractive beach 10 miles north-east of Cowell and was a popular resort for campers and day visitors during the Christmas holidays. It also contained a large number of holiday houses.

Mr. Dunstan said however, at present there was a complete lack of toilet facilities at Lucky Bay, and because of this the Government had decided to make a subsidy.

He said that other subsidies amounting to \$1,250 had already been granted to the District Council of Franklin Harbor this financial year.
