PRESS STATEMENT: 3rd December, 1970.

FROM: THE PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

SUBJECT: BOAT RAMP AT ARNO BAY

The Premier (Mr. Dunstan) said today the Government would pay a subsidy of \$750 to the District Council of Cleve to assist the construction of a boat ramp at Arno Bay.

The ramp will cost a total of \$2,230.

Mr. Dunstan said Arno Bay was becoming an increasingly popular holiday resort not only for people on Eyre Peninsula, but also for people from the Adelaide metropolitan area.

He said there were already 78 holiday homes at the Bay and a caravan park able to accommodate 75 caravans.

"At present there is no boat ramp at Arno Bay. The nearest ones are at Cowell 26 miles away, and Port Neill 22 miles away."
