FROM: THE PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

SUBJECT: WHITE AUSTRALIA POLICY.

Mr. Dunstan said, "I am not unused to the gracelessness of Mr. Gorton's ill-humour, but I think that his criticism of my sending a telegram to the Singapore Prime Minister seeking greater ties between South Australia and Singapore on trade and culture and migration as being unbalanced is itself a sufficient criticism of Mr. Gorton's own statement."
