PRESS STATEMENT: 18th March, 1971.

FROM: THE PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

SUBJECT: PRICE PUBLIC TOILET BLOCK SUBSIDY

The Government has agreed to assist the District Council of Clinton in the cost of building a public toilet block at Price, the Premier (Mr. Dunstan) announced today.

He said that the Government would provide a subsidy of up to \$1,000 on condition that the work was completed by the end of June this year.

Mr. Dunstan said that the area was being increasingly used by tourists and visitors, in particular the small boat owners who used the excellent boat ramp at Price.

He said it was important that adequate facilities should be provided in such potentially important tourist centres.
