PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER & DEVELOPMENT MINISTER, MR. DUNSTAN.

10/9/71.

The State Government had approved a dollar for dollar subsidy up to \$2,200 towards the cost of improving South Coast beach car parks.

The Car Parks are at Port Willunga, Aldinga and Maslin Beach. The Premier said the subsidy had been granted on the assurance of the District Council of Willunga that the car parks would be levelled and consolidated to a standard suitable for sealing with bitumen.

Approval was given on the condition that the work was completed by Christmas eve and the subsidy claimed by February.

Mr. Dunstan noted that the beaches were popular and that good car parks were necessary for the many visitors to them. At present they were in bad order, uneven, pot-holed, eroded and rough.
