PRESS RELEASE FROM COMMUNITY WELFARE MINISTER, MR. KING.

MITCHAM DISTRICT OFFICE.

A new district office of the Community Welfare Department is to be opened at Malvern next week, the Community Welfare Minister, Mr. King, announced today.

It will be at 333 Unley Road, Malvern, and will provide social work services for residents in the local government areas of Unley, Mitcham, Stirling, Mount Barker and the garden suburb of Colonel Light Gardens.

Establishment of this office will make the Department's services more readily available to people in these local communities, Mr. King said.

The office will be staffed by a district officer and seven social workers.

Staff will be available to provide counselling and other services to individuals or families in matters relating to family and child care problems, adoption and fostering.

The office will be open during normal working hours and contacts can be made either personally or by telephoning 72-3755 or 72-3343.
