PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER, MR. DUNSTAN.

NEW MINES DIRECTOR

Mr. Bruce Phillip Webb has been appointed Director of Mines in South Australia, the Premier, Mr. Dunstan, said today.

Mr. Webb, 45, was born in Sydney and educated at the Newcastle Boys High School, Sydney University, and the University of Adelaide, where he obtained a Master of Science degree. He is married, with two daughters.

From 1950 to 1962 he worked as a geologist with the South Australian Mines Department, where he held the position of Senior Geologist for five years.

Mr. Webb then spent three years with Geosurveys of Australia Pty. Ltd., as Chief Geologist and Assistant Manager.

At present he is Exploration Manager and Vice-President of Newmont Pty. Ltd. in Melbourne, and has undertaken two overseas tours in this capacity.

He is a member of the Royal Society of South Australia, the Geological Society of Australia, the Australian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy and the Australian Petroleum Association.

Mr. Webb will take up his new position on the 4th of September.
