PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER, MR. DUNSTAN.

TOURIST SUBSIDY: PORT WILLUNGA, MASLIN AND ALDINGA BEACHES.

25.8.72

The State Government will subsidise the sealing of carparks at three southern beaches, the Premier, Mr. Dunstan, announced today.

Mr. Dunstan, who is also Minister for Tourism, said up to \$2,500 would be provided for bitumenising carparks at Aldinga, Maslin and Port Willunga beaches.

"These parks are used heavily, particularly during the summer months, and the sealing will protect these areas from erosion", he said.

"A Government subsidy of \$2,200 was given last year towards the cost of preparing the carparks to a standard suitable for sealing."

The subsidy has been made available to the District Council of Willunga on a dollar for dollar basis.
