While most of my diggers have been recruited locally, I would still like to hear from one or two experienced, fairly self-reliant people, equipped with their own camping gear, etc. Please get in touch with me, Mr R.J. Two enquiries have come in from people wishing to work as volunteers. Mr J.L. Dalby (Stollards Field, Bredon, Nr Tewkesbury, Glos., GL20 7NE, England) is a "graduate land surveyor with five years experience on all types of large scale land and building surveys", visiting Australia in early 1976. No doubt there will be many field directors competing for Mr Dalby's talents. Another very useful person is Miss Adcock (c/- Eaglehawk High School, Reserve Street, Eaglehawk, Vic. 3556). Miss Adcock, who has a Diploma of Archaeological Studies from the University of Durham, and two years full-time research experience besides, would like to work as a draughtsman on an excavation during January, 1976.
