PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER (MR DUNSTAN)

MOONTA TOURIST SUBSIDIES

4.9.73

The State Government has granted two subsidies to the Corporation of Moonta for tourist development work in the area, the Premier (Mr Dunstan) said today.

A subsidy of \$1,000 had been made towards the cost of sealing two roads - the upper level road at the Port Hughes Caravan Park and the foreshore road south of the jetty at Port Hughes.

Another grant of \$500 had also been made for the building of a toilet block at Simms Cove.

Mr Dunstan said the Government considered both projects very worth while and would help boost the number of tourists travelling to the area.
