PRESS RELEASE FROM THE MEMBER FOR CHAFFEY, MR. CURREN.

HOUSING TRUST CONTRACTS.

18/1/72.

Housing Trust contracts worth \$190,000 have been let for the construction of homes in Waikerie, Renmark and Derri, the House of Assembly Member for Chaffey, Mr. Curren, announced today.

He said the Premier and Housing Minister, Mr. Dunston, had told him that the largest sum was for Waikerie.

There the Trust will construct 11 houses.

Nine of those - eight double and one single unit homes will be in McCutcheon Street. The other two, both single unit houses, will be in Strongman Road.

Total cost of the project is about \$100,000 and the successful tenderers were Delamere Builders Pty. Ltd., Tetalik Pty. Ltd., and A.L. Kevicious.

At Renmark the Trust is to build two single unit double frame houses in Myall Street.

Mr. Curren said the cost was estimated at \$20,000 and the contract had gone to G.A. Ward.

Six double unit homes are to be built at Derri in Paddick Street.

Mr. Curren said the cost was estimated at \$70,000 and the contractor would be W.L. Huckstepp.
