A State Government subsidy of \$6,000 towards the cost of the first stage of alterations and additions to the club room at the Faint Neerlunga Surf Life Saving Club was announced by the House of Assembly Member for Hanson, Mr. Don Hopgood.

He said the Premier and Minister for Tourism, Mr. Dunstan, had told his work is to be completed by March next year.

Mr. Hopgood said the work proposed included a boat shed, change room, toilets and first aid room.

The subsidy is on a dollar for dollar basis, with the estimated total cost being \$12,000.

Mr. Hopgood said surf life saving clubs provided a very valuable service on South Australian beaches, and he was delighted to be able to approve the subsidy.
